We open the XML file and says it is an installation file version 1.5 of Joomla!.

Attention to encode the file in UTF8 for the use of accents and special characters. This remark is valid for all files in the template.

`<name>` parameter must contain the name of the template that should be the same as the directory name.

Then you must list the files to be copied into the site during the installation of the template. If a file is missing from the list it will not be installed.

Because we do not yet know the name nor the architecture of all folders and files we will have at the end, we just prepare the work and finalize the list at the end of the template creation.
